I. Introduction and Purpose

Antioch University publishes an annual Institutional Research Report that provides data for individual campuses and the institution as a whole. Data includes enrollment, financial, and development/advancement information.

II. Policy

Each campus or unit is to designate an individual who is responsible for the collection of institutional research data and working with the University Institutional Research Director to provide the data necessary for the annual report as well as any other research initiatives deemed important or necessary by the Chancellor. Work by the Institutional Research group usually begins in June with a goal of providing the prior year's data as well as five years of trend analysis for the Fall Board of Governors meeting.
