I. Introduction and Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the procedure for each campus of Antioch University regarding the posting of the campus Law Enforcement Statement on its website

II. Procedure

Each campus of Antioch University shall provide the following information (“Law Enforcement Statement”) on its website:

1. A list of all positions on campus with security authority and responsibility (“security personnel”), and a description of that authority and those responsibilities.
2. A description of the working relationship of the campus with local and/or state law enforcement agencies, including any formal documentation of that relationship.

3. A statement that Antioch University encourages strongly all students and employees to report accurately and promptly any suspected crime to security personnel and appropriate law enforcement agencies.
4. Each campus of Antioch University shall keep its Law Enforcement Statement up-to-date on its website. All revisions shall be sent for approval to the Office of General Counsel prior to posting.
